CLP/GHS Regulation – Supplier Compliance Request

Dear Supplier

CLP Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008¹ is the new system on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures manufactured or imported into the EU.

(Amending and repealing directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation EC No 1907/2006 REACH)

From December 1, 2010 on, all raw materials imported into the EU need to be classified, labelled and packaged according to this regulation. Packaging labels (e.g. on drums) for raw materials must show the new hazard pictograms (red borders on white background), signal words (e.g. Danger), hazard- and precautionary statements (H- and P-statements).

Selectchemie as well as our customers demand to obtain material safety data sheets and raw materials packaged and labelled in compliance with this CLP regulation. Regarding the content of the labels on the packagings we particularly refer you to Articles 17-33 of the CLP regulation.

We have customers in European countries speaking many different official languages. To make it easier we demand your hazard and precautionary statements to appear in English language on your labels.

Kindly note some useful links² for guidance on the new system.

We appreciate your cooperation in complying with this regulation for all future raw material deliveries.
